Fisher

North America, Mammal
4 to 13 lb

Eats hare, porcupine, insects, nuts,
berries, and mushrooms

Usually gives birth to 1-4 kits
Conservation Status: Least Concern



Muskox

North America, Mammal
400 to 900 lb

Eats grasses, woody plants, lichens,
and mosses

Usually gives birth to single calf
Conservation Status: Least Concern



Caribou

North America, Mammal
150 to 700 lb

Eats lichens, mosses, leaves, sedges,
and grasses

Usually gives birth to single calf
Conservation Status: Least Concern



Grizzly Bear

North America, Mammal
300 to 800 lb

Eats mammals, fish, birds, carrion,
and plants

Usually gives birth to 1 to 4 cubs
Conservation Status: Least Concern





Ocelot

South America, Mammal
18 to 40 lb

Eats small mammals, lizards,
turtles, frogs, birds, and fish
Usually gives birth to 2-3 kittens
Conservation Status: Least Concern



Capybara

South America, Mammal
75 to 150 lb

Eats grasses, aquatic plants, fruit,
and tree bark
Usually gives birth to four babies
Conservation Status: Least Concern



Giant Anteater

South America, Mammal
60 to 90 lb

Eats mostly ants and termites
Usually gives birth to single pup
Conservation Status: Vulnerable



Green Anaconda

South America, Reptile
60 to 150 lbs

Eats mammals, fish, birds, and
other reptiles
Live birth to 20-40 offspring
Conservation Status: Not Evaluated

World Zoology Control Cards



Pine Marten
Europe, Mammal
3.3 lb

Eats small mammals, carrion,
birds, insects, and fruit
Usually gives birth to 1-5 offspring
Conservation Status: Least Concern



Iberian Lynx
Europe, Mammal
20 to 60 lb

Eats primarily rabbits
Usually gives birth to 2-3 kittens
Conservation Status: Critically
Endangered



European Mink
Europe, Mammal
60 to 90 lb

Eats voles, frogs, fish, crustaceans,
and insects
Usually gives birth to 3-7 kits
Conservation Status: Critically Endangered



Norway Lemming
Europe, Mammal
up to a quarter lb
Eats sedges, grasses, and mosses
Very high reproductive rate
(8 litters, 6 young each per season)
Conservation Status: Least Concern



World Zoology Control Cards



Arabian Oryx

Asia, Mammal

220 to 450 lb

Eats mainly grasses, but also trees, buds, herbs, tubers, and roots

Usually gives birth to single calf

Conservation Status: Vulnerable



Saiga Antelope

Asia, Mammal

80 to 140 lb

Eats several species of plants

Usually gives birth to 1-3 foal

Conservation Status: Critically Endangered



Giant Panda

Asia, Mammal

150 to 350 lb

Eats more than 99% bamboo, also grasses, tubers and some meat

Usually gives birth to 1-2 cubs

Conservation Status: Endangered



Binturong

Asia, Mammal

20 to 70 lb

Eats small mammals, birds, fish, earthworms, insects, and fish

Usually gives birth to 2 offspring

Conservation Status: Vulnerable

Guereza

Africa, Mammal

17 to 30 lb

Eats leaves, fruit, bark, wood, seeds, flowers, soil, & concrete

Usually gives birth to one offspring

Conservation Status: Least Concern



Okapi

Africa, Mammal

440 to 770 lb

Eats leaves, buds, grasses, ferns, fruits, and fungi

Usually gives birth to single calf

Conservation Status: Endangered



Serval

Africa, Mammal

15 to 40 lb

Eats rodents, birds, hares, hyraxes, reptiles, insects, fish, and frogs

Usually gives birth to 2 kittens

Conservation Status: Least Concern



Sitatunga

Africa, Mammal

110 to 275 lb

Eats swamp vegetation, fallen fruit, bark, shrubs, and grasses

Usually gives birth to one offspring

Conservation Status: Least Concern



World Zoology Control Cards



Dingo

Australia, Mammal

30 to 45 lb

Eats mostly medium to large sized mammals

Usually gives birth to 5 pups

Conservation Status: Vulnerable



Wombat

Australia, Mammal

45 to 80 lb

Eats grass and other plant material

Usually gives birth to single joey

Conservation Status: Least Concern



Koala

Australia, Mammal

9 to 33 lb

Eats primarily eucalypt leaves

Usually gives birth to single joey

Conservation Status: Least Concern



Emu

Australia, Bird

40 to 130 lb

Eats plants, insects, seeds, and fruit

Lays around 11 eggs

Conservation Status: Least Concern

Emperor Penguin

Antarctica, Bird

50 to 100 lb

Eats fish, crustaceans, and cephalopods

Lays a single egg

Conservation Status: Near Threatened



Weddell Seal

Antarctica, Mammal

880 to 1360 lb

Eats fish, krill, cephalopods, crustaceans, penguins, & seals.

Usually gives birth to 1 to 2 pups

Conservation Status: Least Concern



Snow Petrel

Antarctica, Bird

about half lb

Eats fish, cephalopods, mollusks, krill, and carrion

Lays a single egg

Conservation Status: Least Concern



Gentoo Penguin

Antarctica, Bird

10 to 20 lb

Eats mainly crustaceans and some fish

Lays 2 eggs

Conservation Status: Near Threatened
